Information required: <i>First- and family name of student / gender / date of birth / email contact / duration of stay / major study programme at IMC Krems</i> 2. Link to online application will be sent to the student by IMC Krems 3. Completion of online application by the student – please note: In case of missing information or documents, the application will not be processed! 4. Reviewing of the submitted online application & feedback to the student / partner university by IMC Krems
Nomination deadlines	Fall Term: May 1 st / Spring Term: November 1 st
Language requirements	For courses in English: minimum B2/C1 For courses in German: minimum C1 As proof of language skills, a language certificate (IELTS, TOEFL, Cambridge Certificate, TELC or similar) must be uploaded as part of the online application/until the start of the exchange semester at the latest.
